- Internal Infrastructure Development
  - IaaS

- Focused GIS application development for citizens
  - Tax Rate Determination Application (BOE)
  - Enterprise Zone Credit Application (FTB and GO-BIZ)
  - EB-5 Foreign Investment Application (GO-BIZ)

# Data

- State of California Geoportal
  - Geoportal is the tool for the State to catalog and document GIS data
  - Metadata is actively harvested and added daily to the catalog
- Property Data
  - SGC and UCD Parcel project MOU near finalization
  - Department of Technology will store and disseminate property related data
    - Data download
    - WMS
- Focus on developing/acquiring important statewide data layers
  - Imagery
  - DTM
  - Land use and Land cover (SGC Project)
  - Roads
  - Parcel data (SGC Project)

# 2014 focus

- Increase internal outreach and coordination
  - [GIS Service Center](#) and Twitter (@CA\_GIS)
  - Data Cataloging in Geoportal
  - Mobile app for GIS resources
- More local outreach
  - Build closer relationships with local GIS collaborative and partners
    - Data sharing
    - Technology sharing
- Explore statewide licensing models for desktop GIS software
  - Cost savings
  - Efficient usage of licenses / Increase access to the tools we need
- Training class for Geoportal (Early 2014)
  - Training to upload, maintain and approve metadata for organizational data
  - In-person and web based training class
